This includes the use of flashes and other photo and video equipment.

All exhibitors agree and understand and that they should be prepared for official photographers, videographers and/or approved mass media taping and/or taking pictures of warm-ups, competition, etc., and upon this condition only are entries accepted.

#### **FACILITY INFORMATION**

#### Arrival & Departure Dates

Horses may arrive at the Built Ford Tough Livestock Complex on Monday, August 5 at 8:00 a.m. Horses must be removed from the Built Ford Tough Livestock Complex no later than midnight on August 18.

#### Health Paper Requirements

All horses are required to have a negative EIA test within the past 12 months and an original Health Certificate within 30 days of the opening date of the show, August 8. Please do not send health papers with your entries. Present coggins and health papers at the stall office.

#### Liability

The owner and any of his/her respective representatives, agents, trainers, lessees, riders, drivers, and handlers (collectively "Related Parties") shall be subject to and bound by the National Snaffle Bit Association (NSBA) by-laws and rules and the rules of this Competition and will accept as final the decision of the Show Manager on any question arising under said rules. Related parties further agree to waive, indemnify, and hold harmless the NSBA, the Competition, officials, officers, directors, employees, independent contractors, agents, personnel, volunteers, the host city Convention & Visitors Bureau, the host facility, trade show vendors, sponsors and/or other sponsoring organizations, if any, for any claim, complaint, or other action taken or pertaining to Related Parties, NSBA and/or this Competition (including Related Parties or any horse of Related Parties exposure to or contraction of communicable diseases).

Presentation of a signed entry form shall be deemed acceptance of these rules and other rules pertaining to this Competition and agreement to the above referenced waiver, indemnification, and hold harmless provisions. In the event of a failure to sign an entry form, the first entry in a class will be deemed acceptance and agreement of same.

Oklahoma law applies to the application and enforcement of this agreement and, under Oklahoma law, two or more persons may agree, in writing, to extend the waiver of liability pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Livestock Activities Liability Limitation Act. By entering this Competition, and signing any waivers required for my participation in NSBA activities including, but not limited to this Competition, I agree to so extend such waiver of liability.

#### Dogs & Pets

Owners assume all liability for pets brought to the show. All pets must be on leashes while on the grounds. No pets are allowed in the arena at any time. As a courtesy to fellow exhibitors, pet owners are required to pick up and dispose of ALL animal waste, especially in the courtyard and esplanade areas. 
All service, support or companion animals (dogs) are prohibited in the show arena during judged competition(s).

# WORLD SHOW ENTRY INFORMATION

The NSBA World Championship Show is open to all breeds recognized by the National Snaffle Bit Association. NSBA recognized breeds include AQHA, APHA, APHA, ABRA, IBHA, PHBA, POA, PtHA and Jockey Club. Horses unregistered with a NSBA recognized breed may be registered with NSBA by submitting the horse's microchip number and verification of age. All horses must be registered for competition per Rule #55.

# Entry Deadlines

All entries for NSBA World Championship and Breeders Championship Futurity classes must be postmarked or emailed to the NSBA office no later than June 25 to avoid post entry fees. Entries must be submitted on an Official Entry Form and once an entry is received by the office it is considered official.

NSBA offers subsequent entry deadlines of July 10 (accepted at the NSBA office), July 11 - 12:00 p.m. the day prior to a class (accepted at show office) and between 12:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. the day prior (accepted at show office) with applicable post entry fees. Entries will be accepted after 5:00 p.m. the day prior until the start of the class with a late fee of \$1,500 plus entry fee. This horse must already be an existing entry at the NSBA World Championship Show or Breeders Championship Futurity/Color Breeders Championship Futurity. Entries will not be accepted after 5:00 p.m. the day prior for a horse that is not already entered into at least one NSBA World Championship Show or Breeders Championship Futurity/Color Breeders Championship Futurity class.

All NSBA World Championship Show entries and payment must be postmarked or completed online at nsba.com on or before the deadline (postal meters are NOT accepted after the deadline). It is recommended that all horse show entries be sent certified mail, express mail or receipt required. NSBA is not responsible for lost or late entries. Once the NSBA office receives an entry it is considered an official entry.

# Payment Policy

Please make checks payable to NSBA World Championship Show in U.S. funds.

Entries will not be considered complete until payment has been received. Checks and credit cards are processed and deposited upon receipt of entries. Any balances will be subject to the appropriate fees based on the date payment is received. Any balances due must be paid in order to pick up back numbers.

NSF Check/Declined Credit Card Policy – A penalty equal to the late fee for the missed payment plus \$50 processing fee will be charged for any NSF check or declined credit card.

# Refund Policy

Refunds of entries and stall fees will be given only in the event of the death of the horse entered. A signed and dated vet certificate must be presented at the entry office no later than 12:00 p.m. the day before the class entered. Refunds will be mailed to the owner after the completion of the NSBA World Championship Show. Once the NSBA office receives an entry it is considered an official entry. Any requests for a refund must be submitted in writing to entries@nsba.com prior to the completion of the show.

# Registration Papers

A copy of the breed registration papers showing current owner (front and back) and an NSBA Certificate of Registration are required to be submitted with entries excluding Heroes on Horses entries. A Certificate of Registration is the horse's official NSBA registration. Please refer to NSBA Rule #55 for registration information.

A Certificate of Registration can be in the form of a Breeders Championship Futurity Certificate, a Stallion Incentive Fund License and/or a Certificate of Registration. A copy of the Breeders Championship Futurity certificate must be enclosed with entries into Breeders Championship Futurity classes.

A \$45 charge will be incurred for any changes to a Certificate of Registration including change in ownership, change in name of horse or a duplicate certificate.

Horses may be matched for identification and age with their registration papers and/or their microchip number.

The NSBA office must be notified in writing of a change in ownership of any entry. A copy of the updated registration certificate must be supplied. A signed transfer will not be accepted as proof of an ownership change. Any prize money won will be mailed to the owner as recorded with NSBA on the last day of the show.

# Membership Cards

NSBA membership is required for both the owner and exhibitor in all classes except Youth Walk Trot, Equestrians With Disabilities and Heroes on Horses. In EWD classes membership is required for exhibitors only.

Current membership cards must be presented at the time of entry. In the event an exhibitor or owner is not a current NSBA member a membership may be purchased with the entry.

# Entry Fees

All entry fees for NSBA World Championship Show and Breeders Championship Futurity classes can be found under "World Show Schedule by Event" on pages 48-54.

# Rider Declaration & Changes

Riders must be declared at the time of entry. Rider changes will be accepted until 12:00 p.m. the day before the class with no additional fee. If the entry is received without a rider declared, the owner will be listed as the rider. Rider changes will be accepted between 12:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. the day before the class with a \$50 fee. Rider changes made after 5:00 p.m. the day before the class will be accepted with a \$200 fee. All rider changes must occur in the entry office before the horse enters the show arena.

Any horse/rider combination shown that differs from the official class list maintained in the entry office will result in disqualification from that class.

# Office Fee

A one time \$75 administrative office charge which includes the drug testing fee will be charged to all horses entered at the NSBA World Championship Show.

#### **Back Numbers**

All back numbers will be issued from the entry office.

# WORLD SHOW STALLING INFORMATION

All horses entered and shown at the NSBA World Championship Show must have a paid stall. Each stall purchased will have 5 bags of Queen Easy Sift shavings included in stalls prior to arrival. Pellet shavings are available through the Expo Feed & Bedding if preferred over provided shavings. Refer to page 58 for contact information.

### Stall Fees

Stalls purchased by June 25 are available at the horse show rate of \$380. A limited number of air-conditioned stalls are available for the horse show rate of \$455 by June 25. All stalls are available on a first come, first paid basis. For stalls purchased after June 25, there is an additional \$75 fee per stall.

# Stall Agent

The stall agent is considered the responsible party for all stalls listed under his/her name and is subject to and bound by all rules as outlined in the NSBA Rulebook and Official Show Premium Book.

A maximum of 16 stalls (including tack stalls) will be assigned to any one designated agent and one person must be designated as agent for the group.

# Payment Policy

**Stall payments must be made separate from entries.** Stall payments and reservations may be made individually; however accuracy of information pertaining to the stalling agent is the responsibility of the exhibitor.

Stall reservations will also be accepted online at nsba.com or emailed at stalls@nsba.com. Do not mail stall reservations if they have been emailed. Exhibitors will receive an email confirming payment and receipt of stall reservations within 24 business hours of submission if sent via email or submitted online.

#### Stall Location

Stalling preference cannot be guaranteed. Priority stalling will be given to sponsors, by level and date sponsorship payment was received. See sponsorship information on pages 37-39. Sponsorship must be received by NSBA no later than July 10 in order to receive stalling perks.

Stalls will be pre-assigned and must be reserved and paid before assignment. Stall reservations will not be considered complete until payment has been received and will be subject to the appropriate fees based on the date payment is received.

Stall reservations received after July 10 will be placed on a first come, first serve basis. Any additions/changes to reservations that are made after this date are not guaranteed to be placed with the original reservation.

# GENERAL SHOW RULES

# Animal Welfare

The National Snaffle Bit Association is committed to the humane and proper treatment of all animals. In this respect:

- 1. The welfare of the horse is the primary consideration in all activities.
- 2. Horses will be treated with kindness, respect and compassion at all times.
- Responsible care will be used by all parties in handling, treatment and transportation of horses.
- Horsemen and women as owners, exhibitors, trainers or agents will ensure the health and well being of animals in their care at all times.

Inhumane treatment of any horse, as defined per NSBA Rule #103, will be grounds for disqualification and/or removal of that horse and all awards will be forfeited.

# Drug Testing

All entries are subject to drug and/or tail testing as defined by NSBA Rule #101. Any owner or handler refusing will be disqualified.

# Leased Horses

Leased horses are eligible to show at the NSBA World Championship Show. An official NSBA lease must be on file as defined by NSBA Rule #64b. During the term of the lease, any money won by the horse at the NSBA World Championship Show, will be paid to the lessee as recorded on the last day of the show. Any money won by the lessee at horse shows will be recorded to their rider earnings.

# Trail Warm Up Fee

The Trail warm up fee is included in the entry fee cost for all horses entered in a World Championship or a Breeders Championship Futurity Trail class excluding EWD classes. The NSBA Foundation sponsors the Trail warm up fee for EWD classes.

# Over Fence Warm Up Fee

A warm up fee of \$25 will be charged to all horses entered in the World Championship Show Working Hunter, Hunter Hack and/or Equitation Over Fences classes. The fence warm up fee is a one-time charge per horse.

#### Substitutions

Substitutions are allowed in the World Championship Show Classes and Breeders Championship Futurity classes for \$50 per class. Substitutions must be made by 5:00 p.m. the day prior to the class. The substitute horse must be owned by the same person or persons as the original entry and must be for the same class as the original entry.

In any Breeders Championship Futurity class, the substitute must already be enrolled in the Breeders Championship Futurity program, or in the case of a horse sired by an enrolled stallion, pay the late enrollment fee.

Substitutions are also allowed in the Youth Walk Trot and Equestrians With Disabilities classes for no additional fee. The substitution must be for the same class as the original entry. Substitutions must be made by 5:00 p.m. the day prior to the class.

# GENERAL SHOW RULES

# Added Money

All World Championship and Stakes classes will be held as offered and all entry fees will be jackpotted. If a class has less than five paid entries, the titles, awards and jackpotted entry fees will be awarded but there will be no added money.

- \$300 or \$320 entry fee (as of June 25):
   Classes with 5-14 paid entries will have \$1,000 guaranteed added money.
   Classes with 15-24 paid entries will have \$2,000 guaranteed added money.
   Classes with 25 or more paid entries will have \$5,000 guaranteed added money.
- \$200 or \$220 entry fee (as of June 25):
   Classes with 5-14 paid entries will have \$1,000 guaranteed added money.
   Classes with 15-24 paid entries will have \$2,000 guaranteed added money.
   Classes with 25 or more paid entries will have \$3,000 guaranteed added money.
- \$75 or \$95 entry fee (as of June 25):
   Classes with 5-14 paid entries will have \$500 guaranteed added money.
   Classes with 15-24 paid entries will have \$750 guaranteed added money.
   Classes with 25 or more paid entries will have \$1,000 guaranteed added money.

All Breeders Championship Futurity Classes and Color Breeders Championship Futurity classes will have added money based on the rules and policies of the program and all entry fees will be jackpotted. Each year, over \$450,000 is paid out in the BCF. Money will be distributed according to the percentage participation in each discipline.

# **Payouts**

Any prize money won will be mailed to the owner as recorded with NSBA on the last day of the show. In the event of a leased horse, any money won by the horse will be paid to the lesee as recorded with NSBA on the last day of the show.

In accordance with Breeders Championship Futurity and Color Breeders Championship Futurity rules, the stallion nominator receives 20%, the foal nominator receives 10%, and the foal owner receives 70% of foal earnings.

All Breeders Championship Futurity classes will pay back up to 10 places. The payback schedule is as follows:

### Results

All results are subject to verification and review. If a tabulation error is suspected, a written inquiry must be submitted to the show office via email at entries@nsba.com within 24 hours after the completion the class. NSBA reserves the right to correct such an error without recourse from entrants. NSBA World Championship Show and Breeders Championship Futurity results are unofficial until the review is completed.

In accordance with NSBA Rule #11d, prize money will be mailed no later than 90 days after the completion of the show pending show results verification and drug test results. A payout check will be held by the NSBA office until a Social Security Number or Tax ID Number is provided if one was not provided at the time of entry or if there is any outstanding balance with the association.

# Right of Cancellation

The National Snaffle Bit Association reserves the right to cancel these events without notice and without liability any time prior to the contests.

# Right of Removal

The National Snaffle Bit Association and World Show Committee reserves the right to prohibit any person or horse from showing, or attending to any horse in the show ring and to remove any person or horse from the grounds without being liable for compensation.



# **QUALIFYING RULES**

# World Championship Show Qualifying Rules

Qualifying is done through participation in each class at Dual Approved events or Special Events. In the Open classes, the horse, and in the Amateur and Youth classes, the horse and rider, will be required to participate in the corresponding dual approved class a minimum of 5 times within the qualifying period of May 1, 2023 through April 30, 2024. Those who are not qualified may enter with an additional \$150 qualification fee per class.

Please note that horses and riders who qualify and are registered with one of NSBA's recognized Color Breed Associations, may show in both the Color and the all breed World Championship classes for which they are qualified. For instance, a registered APHA horse and rider who qualify in Amateur Western Pleasure can show in Color Amateur Western Pleasure and/or Amateur Western Pleasure.

A horse may have met qualification requirements in the previous year as a Green eligible horse. However, NSBA eligibility is based on January 1 of the current show year. Refer to page 65 for Green Horse rules.

An exhibitor may have met qualification requirements in the previous year as a Novice eligible exhibitor. However, NSBA eligibility is based on January 1 of the current show year. Refer to page 64 for Novice Amateur and Novice Youth rules.

Exhibitors who become Amateurs in 2024 must qualify by competing in Amateur classes; Youth classes from the prior year do not count towards the Amateur qualification. Participation on horses that age from the Junior to Senior divisions in 2024 will count towards the Senior division qualification. Limited rider classes in Trail and Western Riding require qualification.

# ELIGIBILITY RULES

It is the responsibility of the owner and/or rider to be aware of the official earnings and points of the horse and/or rider as recorded by NSBA, Equistat, QData (formerly Robin Glenn Pedigrees) and/or recognized breed/equine associations.

Entries in Breeders Championship Futurity or Color Breeders Championship Futurity classes will be accepted only for horses enrolled into the respective program. Secondary or late Breeders Championship Futurity or Color Breeders Championship Futurity enrollment fees are required to be paid in full before showing. Any horse or rider entered into a World Show class in which they are ineligible for may move to a class in which they are eligible without any penalty. Please refer to the refund policy on page 56.

NSBA membership is required for both the owner and exhibitor in all classes except Youth Walk Trot, Equestrians With Disabilities, and Heroes on Horses. In EWD classes membership is required for exhibitors only.

### Non Pro Rules

In Non Pro classes, the horse must be ridden by a Non Pro or Youth NSBA card holder and ownership must follow NSBA rules. The NSBA Non Pro is a Youth as defined by the breed associations recognized by the NSBA (the Youth must be 18 years of age or younger) or an Amateur with a current and valid Amateur card held with one or more of the breed associations recognized by the NSBA or an Amateur that has completed and submitted an NSBA Non Pro Declaration Form.

## Novice Amateur & Novice Youth Rules

In Novice Amateur or Novice Youth classes, the horse must be ridden by a Non Pro, Amateur or Youth card holder and ownership must follow NSBA rules. Eligibility for Novice classes are as follows:

- 1. All Novice riders who hold a breed card\* with eligible novice status as of January 1 of the current show year in the event (Western Pleasure, Hunter Under Saddle, Trail, Western Riding, Showmanship At Halter, Western Horsemanship, Hunt Seat Equitation, Working Hunter, Hunter Hack, Equitation Over Fences) are eligible for the Novice class if both of the following conditions are also met:
  - a. The Novice rider has not won a world or reserve world title in the event in any equine breed association.
  - The Novice rider has not earned more than \$2,500 in Non Pro earnings in the event
- 2. All Novice riders who do not hold a breed card\* with novice status as of January 1 of the current show year in the event are eligible for the Novice class if the following conditions are met:
  - The Novice rider has not earned more than 25 points in the event cumulative across breeds and divisions.
  - b. The Non Pro rider has not won a world or reserve world title in the event in any equine breed association.
  - c. The Non Pro rider has not earned more than \$2,500 in Non Pro earnings in the event.
  - The Novice rider has completed and submitted a NSBA Novice Non Pro Declaration Form.

\*breed Novice/Level 1 status must match the breed of horse being shown.

# ELIGIBILITY RULES

# Amateur Eligibility Rules

An Amateur may show in the 50 & Over classes on or after the day they turn 50 years of age. A 50 & Over Amateur exhibitor may show in the Amateur and the Amateur 50 & Over class with two different horses. A horse may be shown in the Amateur class and the Amateur 50 & Over class with two different exhibitors.

## Youth Walk Trot Rules

Youth Walk Trot classes are for riders 9 & under. Exhibitors may participate on a non owned horse. Horses must be registered with NSBA per Rule #55. NSBA membership for the owner or exhibitor is not required in the Youth Walk Trot classes. An exhibitor may not cross enter into a Lope/Canter class or any other Showmanship classes.

# Amateur Walk Trot Rules

In Amateur Walk Trot classes, the horse must be ridden by an Amateur and ownership must follow NSBA rules. Horses must be registered with NSBA per Rule #55. An exhibitor may not cross enter into an Lope/Canter class but may show in any Showmanship class in which they are eligible.

# Color Horse Rules

A color horse is one who is registered with IBHA, PHBA, PtHA, ABRA, ApHC, APHA, POA. Beginning with horses born in 2019, a solid bred/breeding stock is considered a color horse only if the sire or dam has regular registry papers with one or more of the following associations: APHA, ApHC, ABRA, IBHA, PHBA and POA. PtHA solid registered is not considered a color horse unless it is also registered with one or more of the aforementioned breed associations.

### 3 Year Old Novice Horse Rules

A 3 Year Old Novice Horse is a horse that has not won \$1,000 or more as a 2 Year Old in the event. All monies are considered as recorded by NSBA, any NSBA Recognized Equine Association/Governing Body, Equistat, QData (formerly Robin Glenn Pedigrees).

# \$10,000 Limited Horse Rules

A Maturity \$10,000 Limited Horse is a 4 Year Old and older horse that has not earned more than \$10,000 in Western Pleasure as of January 1 of the current show year. All monies are considered as recorded by NSBA, any NSBA Recognized Equine Association/Governing Body, Equistat, QData (formerly Robin Glenn Pedigrees).

### \$25,000 Limited Horse Rules

A Maturity \$25,000 Limited Horse is a 4 Year Old and older horse that has not earned more than \$25,000 in Western Pleasure as of January 1 of the current show year. All monies are considered as recorded by NSBA, any NSBA Recognized Equine Association/Governing Body, Equistat, QData (formerly Robin Glenn Pedigrees).

### \$2,500 Limited Horse/\$2,500 Limited Rider Rules

A horse of any age that has not earned more than \$2,500 in earnings in Western Pleasure as of January 1 of the current show year ridden by a rider (Open or Non Pro) that has not earned more than \$2,500 in earnings in Western Pleasure as of January 1 of the current show year. All Western Pleasure earnings are considered regardless of whether it was earned in Open, Non Pro or Youth competition. All monies are considered as recorded by NSBA, any NSBA Recognized Equine Association/Governing Body, Equistat, QData (formerly Robin Glenn Pedigrees).

# ELIGIBILITY RULES

## Green Horse Rules

A Green Horse is any horse that has not earned more than 25 points in the event in any NSBA recognized breed association, or more than \$2,500 in earnings in the event (Western Pleasure, Hunter Under Saddle, Trail, Western Riding, Working Hunter, Hunter Hack) as of January 1 of the current show year.

Points from all divisions, cumulative (Youth, Amateur, Open and Green) will count. Novice, EWD and Walk Trot points do not count. All monies are considered as recorded by NSBA, any NSBA Recognized Equine Association/Governing Body, Equistat, QData (formerly Robin Glenn Pedigrees).

### First Year Green Trail

A First Year Green Trail horse is any horse that has not been shown in any Trail class, excluding In Hand Trail, prior to January 1, 2024.

Proof of eligibility must be provided at the time of entry in the form of show record(s) from breed association(s). For horses that are registered with multiple breeds, show records must be presented from each association in which the horse is registered.

Entries presented without show record verification will automatically be entered in the appropriate Green Trail class (Junior or Senior). Upon receipt of show record and verification the entry will be made into the First Year Green Trail class.

# LONGE LINE CLASS RULES

The following Longe Line classes will run concurrently:

In Longe Line classes that run concurrently, an exhibitor may show two horses in the BCF class and two horses in the World Show class. Exhibitors may show the same horse(s) if said horse is entered and eligible in the BCF class and corresponding World Show class.

Exhibitors choosing to show more than one horse must have a handler available while he/she is exhibiting the second horse. Refer to NSBA Rule #193.

Each horse will only be shown once. Horses do not need to be entered into both classes in order to compete. However, if they are entered in both classes separate entry fees are required for each class.

# TRAIL & WESTERN RIDING CLASS RULES

Eligibility will be determined based on the current Official NSBA Riders List.

In Trail and Western Riding classes that run concurrently, only one exhibitor may show in the Open and/or Limited or BCF and/or Color BCF divisions. Each horse will only be

shown once. Horses do not need to be entered into both classes in order to compete. However, if they are entered in both classes separate entry fees are required for each class.

There is no limit to the number of horses one exhibitor may show in any Trail or Western Riding class.

# WESTERN PLEASURE & HUNTER UNDER SADDLE CLASS RULES

Eligibility will be determined based on the current Official NSBA Riders List.

The following Western Pleasure classes will run concurrently:

Horses do not need to be entered into both classes in order to compete. However, if they are entered in both classes separate entry fees are required for each class.

### PERFORMANCE HALTER CLASS RULES

Performance Halter classes require that the horse be entered and shown in at least one other class at the NSBA World Championship Show and Breeders Championship Futurity, outside of the five Performance Halter classes offered. Showmanship At Halter is considered a performance class. If for any reason the horse does not compete in a performance class, the entry will be disqualified and all awards and earnings will be forfeited.

### RANCH CLASS RULES

No horse may cross enter the following classes: Ranch Riding and Western Pleasure, Ranch Rail and Western Pleasure, Ranch Trail and Trail excluding EWD, Walk Trot or Heroes On Horses classes. Ranch Conformation classes require that the horse be entered and shown in at least one other Ranch class (Ranch Riding, Ranch Rail or Ranch Trail) at the NSBA World Championship Show.

# EQUESTRIANS WITH DISABILITIES CLASS RULES

The Built Ford Tough Livestock Complex will provide a mounting ramp. Exhibitors will be responsible for providing any other special mounting needs.

A rider may not show in any other Youth, Amateur or Open categories while showing in the Equestrians With Disabilities classes. A rider may show in only one of the Equestrians With Disabilities categories, Independent or Supported. If a rider's condition deteriorates so that the rider can no longer ride as an independent rider, but now needs support, this must be documented by the physician and if participating in a therapeutic riding program, the certified PATH instructor. A copy of documentation must be provided to NSBA.

Horses must be registered with NSBA per Rule #55.

Handler attire must meet the requirement of NSBA Rule #136 or #139 with the exception that hats are not required. However, if a hat is worn it too must meet the standard of Rule #136 or #139.

# OVER FENCE CLASS RULES

# Markel Insurance NSBA Hunter Derby

The Markel Insurance NSBA Hunter Derby open to all horses registered with NSBA. The class will be a two round hunter classic format with jumps at 3'0" in height with three or four option jumps at 3'3" in height. The jumps will consist of some natural jumps that would be seen out in a hunt field. The first round will be judged in an open numerical score format with at least three optional jumps receiving one (1) bonus point each harder option taken. Then the top 15 scores from the first round will come back for a second round. The second round will be a handy hunter round with at least three option jumps incorporated in the course. The second round will be scored with an open numerical score format with one (1) bonus point for each harder option taken. All ties will be broken using the first round base score. Judges may not award the same base score above the cut off.

Also a 0-10 bonus points will be given to the level of handiness executed during the handy course. All these scores will then be added together for the score of the second round. Both round one and two will be added together to determine the winner. The class will follow NSBA Working Hunter rules.

The Hunter Derby entry fee is \$125 by June 25. See pages 48-54 for fee schedule. Open and Non Pro exhibitors show together.

\$5,000 purse is paid out as follows: 1 - \$1,500, 2 - \$1,000, 3 - \$800, 4 - \$600, 5 - \$400, 6 - \$300, 7 - \$200, 8 - \$100, 9 - \$50, 10 - \$50

The highest placing Non Pro will also receive a \$1,000 bonus.

# Working Hunter Under Saddle Rules

A horse must be shown in a minimum of one Over Fence class in any division (i.e. Youth, Amateur, Open). This requirement may be met by participating in any of the NSBA World Championship Show classes and/or Markel Insurance NSBA Hunter Derby.

A horse may be shown by an Open or Non Pro exhibitor. If shown by a Non Pro, ownership rules prevail as outlined in Non Pro Rules on page 64. NSBA Hunter Under Saddle rules prevail.

A horse shown in Working Hunter Under Saddle may not show in any other Hunter Under Saddle class at the NSBA World Championship Show & Breeders Championship Futurity excluding EWD and Walk Trot.

# HEROES ON HORSES CLASS RULES

NSBA will offer a "Heroes On Horses" competition to honor our service men and women and the horses that are helping them heal.

Veterans are invited to participate in the NSBA World Championship Show "Heroes On Horses" competition.

Exhibitors must be disabled veterans who are participating in PATH Intl. Equine Services for Heroes Programs or who have a Department of Veteran Affairs disability rating.

The PATH facility will be responsible for verifying the eligibility of riders participating in Equine Services for Heroes Programs.

For Disabled Veterans who do not participate in a therapeutic riding program, please attach to entry form the Department of Veteran Affairs letter recording the dates of service, the Service-connected Disability Rating, and the date it was awarded. Please black out all other personal information included in the letter such as social security number and monthly award.

Horses do not need to be registered or owned by the rider or facility.

Per NSBA Rule #128 I), all service, support or companion animals (dogs) are prohibited in the show arena during judged competition(s).

To enter the NSBA World Championship Show, the Heroes on Horses forms must be submitted with the NSBA World Championship Show Entry Form. There will be no fee for participation in this class. Exhibitors are encouraged, but not required to be members of the NSBA.

A blind or hearing impaired exhibitor may have an assistant who communicates via verbal or sign language or cue cards to the competitor so they may hear the judge's directives. This assistant to the blind or hearing impaired exhibitor may be inside or outside the ring and their position known to the judge and ring steward.

Once the class has started, unauthorized assistance from horse leaders, spotters and side walkers will result in penalties. Side walkers may not give verbal commands or extra physical prompting, except in case of emergency. Handlers, leaders, side walkers, or extra spotters other than the required horse handler are not considered tack or equipment. No cell phones are allowed during competition by handlers.

Handler attire must meet the requirement of NSBA Rule #136 or #139 with the exception that hats are not required. However, if a hat is worn it too must meet the standard of Rule #136 or #139.

All horses when ridden must wear a halter in a manner that does not interfere with reining of the horse. A halter must be on the horse either over or under the bridle for use by the handler if needed. All exhibitors should be able to hold reins.

A snaffle bit, curb bit or bosal/hackamore may be used no matter the age of the horse.

Exhibitors are allowed to ride with one or two hands at any time during the class. Exhibitors are allowed to hold the saddle with either hand without penalty.

The Built Ford Tough Livestock Complex will provide a mounting ramp. Exhibitors will be responsible for providing for any other special mounting needs.

Exhibitors must wear a properly fitted and fastened helmet with harness, ASTM approved protective helmet. A western hat may be affixed over the helmet in Western events. Equipment should conform to the riding ability of the competitor and be suitable for the horse.

Acceptable adaptive equipment includes but not limited to the following:

- Saddle raised pommel, raised cantle, hard hand holds, soft hand holds, seat saver, knee rolls/blocks, thigh rolls/blocks, padded saddle flaps
- Stirrups rubber bands around foot and stirrup, enclosed stirrups, strap
  from stirrup leather to girth/cinch, strap from stirrup to girth/cinch, no stirrups,
  one stirrup
- 3. Bridle/Reins looped reins, connecting bar reins, bridging rein, ladder reins, rein guides (rein through ring on saddle), elastic insert in reins, side pulls
- 4. Whips one or two whips, strap attaching whip to hand
- Riding Attire no boots if using safety stirrups (Peacock, s-shaped irons or Devonshire stirrups), modified riding boots, gaiters, half chaps, off set spurs, safety vest
- Posture, Postural Supports & Orthoses L or R arm sling, neck collar, ankle foot orthoses, prosthesis, wrist brace, back support, trunk support, gait belt
- Other aids commander using sign language, enlarged arena letters, audio communications (for hearing impaired), voice, bareback pads, surcingles

# CINCH HORSEMANSHIP INVITATIONAL RULES

Nationally ranked Horsemanship exhibitors are formally invited to compete for a \$15,500 purse in the 2024 CINCH Horsemanship Invitational.

All exhibitors, excluding Walk Trot exhibitors, who earned a top ten placing in the NSBA portion of a Horsemanship class at one of NSBA's alliance breed organizations' Championship shows, or at the NSBA World Championship Show in 2023, are invited to participate.

Finals will be held on Wednesday, August 14, in the Ford Truck Arena, with a finals party sponsored by CINCH. A preliminary round will be held on Tuesday, August 13, if entries warrant. In the event of a preliminary round, finalists will advance based on pattern work only (no rail work).

### How It Works

Four CINCH Invitational specific Horsemanship patterns will be released as part of the official NSBA World Championship Show pattern booklet. One of the four patterns will be selected for competition at the start of the class.

Exhibitors will have ten minutes to warm up once one of the four patterns have been declared. Only exhibitors are allowed to be on horseback during the warm up time. Trainers/coaches will be allowed in the arena during the warmup period; however, trainers/coaches cannot ride an exhibitor's horse during the warm up period.

Exhibitors may use the warm up time at their discretion, but it is mandatory that all exhibitors be present in the Ford Truck Arena at this time.

Once the class begins, all trainers/coaches will be excused and will not be allowed to coach from the rail and an exhibitor may only walk their horse until three horses prior at which time they may walk and jog only.

## Class Rules

This event is rider-specific. A rider does not have to compete on the same horse they qualified with, however, Non-Pro ownership and eligibility rules, as outlined in the NSBA Handbook, must be met to compete. Owners and exhibitors are required to be NSBA members and horses are required to be registered with the NSBA.

All age groups and levels are eligible. Only qualified individuals may compete.

Eligible individuals do not need to qualify or compete in any other classes at the NSBA World Championship Show in order to compete in the CINCH Horsemanship Invitational.

This class will be judged based on Horsemanship rules as outlined in the official NSBA Handbook.

# Entry Information

All eligible riders have been sent an invitation based on the results provided by each of NSBA's alliance breed associations. A complete list is also available at <a href="https://www.nsba.com/cinch">www.nsba.com/cinch</a>. All exhibitors must enter on an official World Championship Show entry form.

Entry Deadlines are as follows:

June 25 - \$0 (accepted at NSBA office in Weatherford, TX)

June 26 - July 10 - \$75 (accepted at NSBA office in Weatherford, TX)

July 11 - August 12 - \$125 (accepted at show office in Tulsa, OK)

Entries close at 5:00 p.m. on August 12. All exhibitors must check-in at the show office no later than August 12 to maintain their entry.

# **Payouts**

A total of \$15,500 will be awarded across five different categories listed below.

In order to be eligible for the Novice Division bonus, an exhibitor must have qualified by placing in the NSBA top ten in a Novice/Level 1 Horsemanship class at one of NSBA's alliance breed organizations' Championship shows, or at the NSBA World Championship Show in 2023.

In order to be eligible for the Amateur 50 & Over bonus, an exhibitor must have qualified by placing in the NSBA top ten in a 50 & Over/Amateur Select Horsemanship class at one of NSBA's alliance breed organizations' Championship shows, or at the NSBA World Championship Show in 2023.

In order to be eligible for the Alliance Breed bonus, an exhibitor must have qualified by placing in the NSBA top ten in at one of NSBA's alliance breed organizations' Championship shows. For example, an exhibitor that qualified through placing at the ApHC World Show would be eligible for the ApHC Alliance Breed bonus. An exhibitor placing in the Overall Top 10, will not be awarded the Alliance Breed bonus.

Any exhibitors who declares a trainer will make their trainer eligible for bonus payouts. A trainer may win only one trainer bonus. In the event that one trainer would win more than one bonus, the next highest placing trainer will receive the bonus payout.

# CLASS PROCEDURE & JUDGING

# Class Procedure

All classes will be shown under NSBA rules unless NSBA World Championship Show and Breeders Championship Futurity rules differ, then, NSBA World Championship Show and Breeders Championship Futurity rules will apply. NSBA reserves the right to use any patterns not presented in the NSBA rulebook.

A two-minute gate rule will be enforced. After the final call for a class has been given, the gate will be closed in two minutes and no late participants will be accepted. Barn calls are made as a courtesy. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be aware of the progression of the show and be ready for their class when it enters the arena. No refunds for missed classes.

Working orders and splits will be posted at each arena the evening prior. All disputes and decisions, including class splits, shall be decided by the show management and shall be final and considered accepted by all exhibitors.

# Equipment Judges

Equipment Judges shall be responsible for attire and equipment rule interpretations. Final interpretations are the responsibility of show management. All bits, tack, appointments and attire shall be checked by the equipment judge prior to entering the arena. Any equipment considered to be inhumane or illegal by the official equipment judge must be removed or entry into the arena will be denied. The equipment judge may disqualify an entry for the presence of blood on the horse.

Once the horse has been checked in and enters the designated warm-up area, training equipment will no longer be allowed.

# **Conflicts**

In the event that a horse or exhibitor is entered in two or more classes in separate arenas that have a potential to be showing at the same time, the Arena Coordinator and back gate staff must be notified by filing a Class Conflict Form with each arena at least one class prior to the conflict.

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to notify the Arena Coordinator at each arena and complete Class Conflict Forms. Class Conflict Forms are available at all arenas.

Every reasonable attempt will be made by show management to accommodate horses and exhibitors showing in conflicting arenas. Arenas will not be held due to conflict. Exhibitors may have to choose which class to participate in and which to forego. Refunds will not be given in the event of a conflict.

The Ford Truck Arena will take precedence on the schedule. The Mustang Arena, then Pavilion will take precedence after the Ford Truck arena.

# Judging

Each class judged by four judges will have the lowest placing of the four judges eliminated for each horse. Each class judged by three judges will use all three placings to determine the final placings. When two or more classes are run concurrently, each class will be placed separately for the purpose of point distribution in calculating class placings. In the event that the judge submits an overall placing card, show management will transfer the Limited division to the appropriate card so long as the classes are placed separately for point tabulation and recording. The designated tiebreaker judge will break all ties. Decisions of the judges will be final.

# YEARLING SALE GRADUATES

# Markel Insurance Breeders Championship Futurity Yearling Sale

The Markel Insurance Breeders Championship Futurity Yearling Sale is a limited consignment sale designed to bring many of the nation's top yearlings to public sale. The sale is only open to yearlings enrolled in the NSBA Breeders Championship Futurity and/or Color Breeders Championship Futurity. The sale is held in conjunction with the NSBA World Championship Show each year.

Proceeds from the sale are used to fund a purse exclusively held for sale graduates. Sale graduates are then eligible to compete for the purse at the Breeders Championship Futurity in their two or three year old year.

In order to compete for the additional purse, horses must be consigned and sold through the Breeders Championship Futurity Yearling Sale.

The Markel Insurance Breeders Championship Futurity Yearling Sale will take place on Friday, August 16 at 5:00 p.m., with a preview of all consigned yearlings on Thursday, August 15 at 5:00 p.m. at the Built Ford Tough Livestock Complex in Tulsa, Oklahoma.

# Yearling Sale Graduate Declaration Procedure & Rules

To be eligible for the Yearling Sale Alumni Purse, horses must be a 2022 or 2023 Yearling Sale Graduate and be entered in a Breeders Championship Futurity or Color Breeders Championship Futurity class.

Declaration forms for all Graduates can be found on the back of the Graduate Certificate. Owner and exhibitor information including NSBA membership numbers are required in order to complete the declaration form.

Sale Graduates may select only one two year old or one three year old class for the Yearling Sale Alumni Purse and once a declaration is received it is considered official and no other changes will be accepted. Declaration of the Breeders Championship Futurity or Color Breeders Championship Futurity class must be completed at the sale office no later than 5:00 p.m. the day prior to the scheduled class.

A Yearling Sale Graduate Certificate of Eligibility will need to be presented at the time of entry. A \$45 charge will be incurred for a duplicate certificate.

Owners and exhibitors are responsible for knowing which Breeders Championship Futurity or Color Breeders Championship Futurity class they are entered in. If the sale graduate is not entered in the Breeders Championship Futurity or Color Breeders Championship Futurity class that is declared, the horse will be automatically disqualified and ineligible to compete for the Yearling Sale Alumni purse.

Sale graduates must place in the top ten of their declared Breeders Championship Futurity or Color Breeders Championship Futurity class to be eligible for the Yearling Sale Alumni purse. Money will be calculated based on the number of declared sale graduates placing in the top ten and distributed accordingly.





# ALL AROUND AWARDS

NSBA will award All Around Awards at the NSBA World Championship Show. Each of the nine divisions will be awarded an All Around Belt Buckle.

To be eligible a horse (Open), exhibitor (EWD) or horse/rider combination (Youth, Amateur and Novice) must participate in a minimum of three classes per division.

All Around Award ties will be broken by (1) the horse or contestant winning over the greatest number of horses, (2) the number of points earned in the greatest number of classes, and (3) in head to head competition, the horse or horse/rider combination that placed higher the most times.

# Open All Around

All Green, Junior and Senior classes, Open Ranch classes, Open Pleasure Driving, Open Working Hunter and Working Hunter Derby will count towards the Open All Around

Participation in the Performance Halter is not required but any points earned in halter will count towards the Open All Around Award.

## Amateur All Around

All Amateur classes will count towards the Amateur All Around. Any points earned in Novice Amateur or Amateur 50 & Over classes will not count towards the Amateur All Around.

# Amateur 50 & Over All Around

All Amateur 50 & Over All Around.

Any points earned in Novice Amateur or Amateur classes will not count towards the Amateur 50 & Over All Around.

### Novice Amateur All Around

All Novice Amateur classes will count towards the Novice Amateur All Around. Any points earned Amateur or Amateur 50 & Over classes will not count towards the Novice Amateur All Around

## Novice Amateur 50 & Over All Around

All Novice Amateur 50 & Over classes and all age Novice Amateur Western Riding will count towards the Novice Amateur All Around. Any points earned Amateur or Amateur 50 & Over classes will not count towards the NoviceAmateur 50 & Over All Around.

### Youth 13 & Under All Around

All Youth 13 & Under classes will count towards the Youth 13 & Under All Around. Any points earned in an All Age Youth class will be distributed based on the age of the rider. Any points earned Novice Youth classes will not count towards the Youth 13 & Under All Around.

### Youth 14-18 All Around

All Youth 14-18 classes will count towards the Youth 14-18 All Around. Any points earned in an All Age Youth class will be distributed based on the age of the rider. Any points earned Novice Youth classes will not count towards the Youth 14-18 All Around.

# ALL AROUND AWARDS

# Novice Youth All Around

All Novice Youth classes will count towards the Novice Youth All Around. Any points earned in Youth (13 & Under or 14-18) will not count towards the Novice Youth All Around.

# Youth Walk Trot All Around

All 9 & Under Youth Walk Trot classes will count towards the Youth Walk Trot All Around. Any points earned in Youth (13 & Under or 14-18) or Novice Youth classes will not count towards the Youth Walk Trot All Around.

# Equestrians With Disabilities Division

All Equestrians With Disabilities (Supported and Independent) classes will count towards the Equestrians With Disabilities All Around. This award will be based on the exhibitor regardless of the horse(s) used for competition.

# Ranch Horse High Point - Non Pro & Open

All NSBA World Championship Show Non Pro Ranch classes will count towards the Non Pro high point saddle.

All NSBA World Championship Show Junior and Senior Ranch classes will count towards the Open high point saddle.

# YOUTH TEAM TOURNAMENT

Open to all Youth entered in NSBA World Championship Show Youth classes. Futurity and Maturity classes do not count. Teams of no more than five exhibitors will be drawn based on the number of entrants. Once teams are drawn, each youth will choose up to two classes to designate as their Youth Team Tournament Class(es).

There is no additional entry fee. A Draw Party will be held for participants prior to competition.

Results will be tabulated and updated throughout the day on signage to keep teams abreast of their current rank. Team awards will be given to the first place through third place team. Points are awarded based on team members' placing in their designated classes. See point chart below.

# Entry Information

Pre entries for the Show Your Colors Show will be accepted online or via Horse Show Tracker

NSBA classes are denoted starting with show bill number 1000, AQHA classes are denoted starting with 2000 and APHA classes are denoted starting with 3000. An exhibitor may enter the AQHA and/or APHA portion of a class once the NSBA portion is entered.

# Entry Fee Information

NSBA classes: \$15 per class

AQHA/APHA classes (concurrent with NSBA): \$10 per class

Office Fee: \$10 per horse
Trail Warm Up Fee: \$10 per horse
Over Fence Warm Up Fee: \$10 per horse

AQHA Admin Fee: \$10 per judge (if entering AQHA class) APHA Show Result Fee: \$1 per class (if entering APHA class)

Warm Up Classes: \$25 per class/run

# Warm Up Classes

NSBA will offer warm up classes denoted starting with show bill number 8000.

In Western Pleasure and Hunter Under Saddle warm up classes, each class will be limited to 25 participants. On Trail, Western Riding and Ranch Riding warm up days, the first 125 entries will be accepted, with each horse being allowed one run within the first 125 openings. If time permits, additional runs may be made available at which time a horse may have a second run allowed.

All horses must have a back number and enter their respective warm up class(es) at the horse show office. Entries for warm up classes will not be taken prior to show office opening on Wednesday, August 7. If a horse is not entered in a Show Your Colors class, they may obtain a back number from the show office and pay the \$10 office fee.

# Payment Policy

Please do not send payment at the time of pre entry. All payments will be processed at the show office.

# Show Office


The Show Your Colors entry office will open Wednesday, August 7. During the horse show, the Show Your Colors entry office will open at least one hour prior to start of competition.

One All Around Bronze Trophy will be awarded in each of the following divisions: Amateur, Amateur Select, Youth, Youth Walk Trot .One All Around Harris Leather & Silverworks saddle will be awarded in each of the following divisions: Novice Amateur. Novice Youth






